Preface

BACKGROUND: BRAHMARISHI PRASHAR MEMORIAL TRUST is a non-profitable and non-political grass root level voluntary Organization. The organization came into existence during 2013 under Seraikella Kharsawan district towards helping people to raise their voice against exploitation, corruption, violence and infringement of basic Human Rights. BRAHMARISHI PRASHAR MEMORIAL TRUST is emphasized to consciousness of people for better management of their resources. BRAHMARISHI PRASHAR MEMORIAL TRUST is a registered under the Indian Trust Registration Act, 1882

The organization is working in collaboration with other like-minded NGOs in the block of villages under Seraikella Kharsawan District in Jharkhand. It has been functioning on various environmental issues. It has organized padayatras, Rally, wall writing to make people aware on Dalit Rights, Child Rights, and Human Rights. They also fought against wage discriminations.

While working in villages baghruidih, bargain, santari, bitaburu, raidih, narayanpur, rengudih, jagannathpur, sokandih and nayadih under Seraikella-Kharsawan district, the organization found various issues in these villages: -

Meeting: -

BRAHMARISHI PRASHAR MEMORIAL TRUST organized meeting with villagers and women's group. **BRAHMARISHI PRASHAR MEMORIAL TRUST** workers discussed to village governance system; identify village problems, village resources and village development. The villagers share their views in every meeting. The villagers have been feeling that Village unity is essential in the present situation. The villagers have been taking decision that regular meeting arrange of *Gramsabha* and contacted to the all villagers and write up to the minutes, rules and regulation of *Gramsabha*.

Seminar: -

BRAHMARISHI PRASHAR MEMORIAL TRUST organized one day seminar in each Panchayat for information sharing with villagers as well as PRI rules and regulation, Forest conservation rules and regulation, effect on Globalization in our village community, different types of Govt. Schemes and also our role and responsibility in that present situation. the seminar was attended by many male and female leaders, who are leaders in their gramsabha and Self-Help Groups. They discussed their village problems and found many viable solution method. Most of the important issues analyzed include migration problems, unemployment, poverty, superstitions which are found due to lack of livelihood job opportunity.

Women Conference: -

In this year our organization have been organized a Block level women conference at Golmuri-cum-Jugsalai. Above all 130 women have been participated in this conference, which are coming from SHG, Gramsabha, Govt.officers, etc in East Singhbhum district, This conference has been discussed women issues, women's participation in developmental work, women's right, self-employment, self-confidence of women.

Wall writing: -

BRAHMARISHI PRASHAR MEMORIAL TRUST workers have been writing up to the slogan in the village wall on the child rights, human rights, women participation, women's rights, *Gramsabha* rights in our constitutions etc. Most effective part of the awareness program, which is easy contact and awareness create in the people.

Rally and Dharna: -The Rally and Dharna program has been organized by our workers and volunteers on the issues of Migration, pollution, human rights, Child rights, Dalit rights. The cycle rally has organized by 100 volunteers from Village to Village for campaign on education rights, human rights and radiation effect. Another Rally organized to block development office to pressurized govt. department to properly utilized of Govt. Schemes and timely duties of govt. staffs as for block development office, Health department, school, ICDS etc. Having created awareness of mass people and sensitized of Govt. Staffs and also alert of their role and responsibility.

Awareness on Health: -

Our organization has been organized health awareness camp Golmuri-cum-Jugsalai, which is effect on HIV/AIDs by different state people who are come in national highway in this area with carry HIV/AIDs after sexual intercourse to infection in our areas women and man. Increase in miscarriage, infant mortality, congenital deformities, skeletal deformities, skin diseases, cancer, leukemia, thalassemia, mega cephalic, micro cephalic, nervous system disorder have been increased in the area.

Our organization has been organized mother and child health care program through regular meeting with Self-Help Group like as convince to their child immunization, family planning, food value and preservation of food nutrition, etc.

Maximum mother are not knowledgeable of local fruit and food nutrition and its preservation process. Our workers are being trained up from different NGO/Govt. department and them also sharing their knowledge with women.

Women groups are taking initiative to cleaning their family house and also community use place like as tube well, dug well, Brahmashri Prashar Memorial Trust etc.

Women Organization: -

BRAHMARISHI PRASHAR MEMORIAL TRUST has ensured women participation in Gramsabha for rebuilding of village. Our organization has organized to the women's group by the group meeting, dialogue and formation Self-Help Group. Women's group have been arranged regular meeting and discussed their problems. They want to develop their economic status and social respect to ensure them social security by women's organization. The Gramsabha has been giving value to the women and ensured women representative in all committee as for Gramsabha, *Kissan* Committee etc. The women's SHG has been formed a federation committee in Panchayat level to block level. The federation committee has been helped to SHG by capacity building program, Govt. support program etc. All SHG have been started their savings process and also regularized. They want to get self-employment opportunity by income generation program with the help of their regular savings money. They want to free of financial matter, which is bounded to done any work by the vested interested person/middle men wishes in their emergency period. In this period

they have been exploited physically, mentally and economically by the middleman so, they have saving their money for support to emergency period. The SHG is regular maintaining their minute book, cash and ledger book etc. Women's Empowerment must be come by the micro-credit and micro enterprise program.

Women Empowerment: -



BRAHMARISHI PRASHAR MEMORIAL TRUST was organized different type of workshop, training, seminar, regular meeting with women for social, economical, political and cultural development. In that above program have been discussed women's issues, women's rights, skill and knowledge of their traditional

habitat, development concept and essential of women participation etc. Women have been full participated in that program and they have been followed up that knowledge. Women Empowerment is focused by spontaneously participated in our different workshop, seminar, conference, which program is organized by women and also they have been looking for their solution method with the support of NGO & Govt. Women empowerment program is covered by our following activities. :-

SHG Workshop on Reporting and Documentation.



In this workshop have been participated of all SHG leaders. Our organization have been organized and contacted to the resource person, which are facilitated of the maintained of minutes book, cash and ledger book and also other correspondence matter. After this training they have been maintaining their regular meeting report and other related document.

Gender equity

Our organization organized one workshop on gender equity. The workshop was participated by workers and SHG leaders. The Resource persons discussed various development concept essential for male and female participation in all developmental work in present situation. Most of the participants highlighted that gender equity is not neglected in this area of our traditional tribal culture but it is essential for progress to create their awareness by participation of regular meetings, seminars, conference etc. and also

increased attendance of all social, political, cultural & other developmental activities.

WOMEN CONFERENCE ON WOMEN ISSUES

Legal Awareness Workshop

Women have learnt how to move ahead towards economic freedom and making their presence felt in the society. It is high time when their subservient position in society needs to end with fresh lease of knowledge, skill and information inputs for amelioration of development works at village level. The holding of village level legal awareness camp and discussion of women rights, dowry system, witch craft, women atrocities, domestic violence and other rights and entitlements by the facilitator lawyer has opened new avenues of knowledge and information among women community at grassroots. It was highly successful as women came forward to ask varied questions regarding their legal rights and provisions of law to deal with issues concerning women. The large turnout of rural women in this workshop send a message among the community that women have started to equip themselves with knowledge, skill and information for their self respect in society. The facilitators also discussed women land right/property right act for women, FIR process, PNDA act, sexual harassment act, domestic violence act, widow act, Hindu marriage act, consumer protection act were some of the key issues discussed during the workshop. Women have been at the helm of affairs in fighting social evils like drug addiction, gambling, alcoholism prevalent at village level.

Youth Empowerment



Youth empowerment has been a key component on the agenda of BRAHMARISHI PRASHAR MEMORIAL TRUST. While dedicating its services to the cause of tribal youths, scheduled caste and other deprived sections of society; the organization has given top priority to

youth related works. The driving force behind motivating youth comes from organizational endeavor and efforts for finding suitable income generation activities and organizing need based training programme for their socio-economic consolidation. Three week training on skill development of rural sports person was undertaken by the organization. Altogether 22 sports youth were selected for their league matches at district level. It was a proud moment for our team when they faced the team of East Singhbhum

Formation of Youth Club

The formation of youth club and adolescent girls club in 6 targeted villages has given strength to our youth related programs and activities. It has enabled village youth to participate in our programs and activities. We have our youth teams who look after activities at grassroots level. This also enables us to remain in constant touch with village level issues. The organization has always given top priority to tribal youths in all its programmes and activities. The youth clubs of tribal and scheduled caste youth have been formed and they were given top priority in fishery development programme. The women folk in tribal community have been the source of main bread earner for their family.

Agriculture



Agriculture has been given the top priority by the organization to consolidate the tattered village economy. It was a part of our strategy to collaborate with different stakeholders for promotion of modern farming methods and approaches at grassroots level. The organization has decided to expedite the process of scientific

farming and has also plans in pipeline to form committee of scheduled tribe and scheduled caste youths in remote areas for improving their livelihood through intervention at agriculture field while promoting modern methods of farming among the rural farmers. The farmers belonging to self help groups and gram sabha program executive committee were distributed ground nut, paddy, ginger, wheat and gram of new variety for high yield production. Apart from this, cultivation of tomato, potato, brinjal, cucumber, chilly, lady finger etc. vegetables was also promoted among 105 farmers belonging to 10 villages under Seraikella-Kharsawan district, namely baghruidih, bargain, santari, bitaburu, raidih, narayanpur, rengudih, jagannathpur, sok andih and nayadih. The distribution of plantation of lichi, mango, and coconut among 215 farmers has yielded good result and villages have become more conscious about their environment.

Kisan Club & FFS

The formation of farmers club at village level has been further taken as a task to facilitate agriculture development in more scientific way at village level. The village farmers have been trained in making vermin compost, raising nursery, formation of community forest management committee, fodder development and other scientific innovations to increase their crop productivity. Altogether 9 such kisan club has been formed in targeted villages.
